Here at the Belfry we have around 200 regular and 75 casual volunteers. A regular volunteer is someone who volunteers approximately 4 times per season. For example a regular volunteer may work the first Thursday of each Main Stage show, as a ticket taker. A casual volunteer is someone who would like to volunteer but either there are no regular shifts available or they are only available once in a while and can not commit to a regular shift. In exchange for your time we offer you a seat in the house to enjoy the show on the day/night you volunteer.

We have an amazing collection of volunteers, some of whom have been volunteering here for over 25 years. There are 8 volunteer team leaders who look after scheduling. They also have access to a list of casual volunteers who are available to fill in should a regular need to be replaced.
