

# Visiting the Belfry



## BUS SERVICE

The Belfry is serviced directly by the 22 Haultain / Burnside Bus. Routes 1, 2, 10, 24, 25, 27 & 28 all stop within three blocks of the theatre. Routes 11 & 14 stop within five blocks of the theatre.

## TAXI

Our Front of House Manager will be happy to call a taxi for you following the show. The FOH Office is to the left of the Box Office.

## BICYCLES

There are a number of bike racks in the square outside the theatre.

## WHEELCHAIR ACCESS

The Belfry is fully wheelchair accessible, including a wheelchair accessible washroom. As space within the theatre is limited, we ask you to book wheelchair seating in advance. Please let us know if you have an attendant with whom you wish to sit.

## LATECOMERS & RE-ADMISSION

The Director of each production designates moments in the show when the seating of latecomers will cause the least amount of distraction for actors and audience members. Should you leave the theatre, our House Manager will reseal you during one of these breaks.

## GUIDE & COMPANION DOGS

Guide and medically required companion dogs are welcome in the theatre. For audience safety and comfort you must inform us that you are bringing a dog when you book your tickets.

## PERFUME & COLOGNE

Please refrain from using perfume and cologne when you come to the theatre. Some of our patrons are highly allergic to scents.

## FREE PARKING

You may park free of charge in the Victoria High School parking lot during any evening or weekend performance. During our weekday matinees, that parking lot is reserved, and your car will be towed. Please use the street parking indicated on the map. If you park in zones marked "Residential" you will be ticketed.

## AUDIENCE ADVICE / RUNNING TIMES

We make every effort to make you aware of any language, subject matter or technical advisories (strobe lights, special effects) we have in effect. Please look for signs at the entrances to the theatre. You may also call the Box Office at 250-385-6815 after the first preview – they will have the latest information.

## TICKET EXCHANGES

Tickets may be exchanged for another performance (within that production / subject to availability) providing they are received at the Box Office at least 24 hours prior to the performance for which they were issued. Exchanges are \$1 per ticket up to a total of \$5. Exchanges are free for season ticket holders but an upgrade fee may apply.
